










#### **DEMOGRAPHY OF POLAND IN 2050**

#### **CAUSES OF DEATH AND HEALTH PROBLEMS**

### Main causes of death (percentage of all deaths)

		general population	people 60+
	Cardiovascular diseases	41	46
•	Malignant neoplasms	25	25
	Respiratory system diseases	7	7

### The main health problems of seniors

- Hypertension 75% of people over 60 years of age
- Depression 26% of the elderly
- · Chronic kidney disease 21% of people over the age of 65
- Malignant neoplasms 9.7% of seniors have had or are living with cancer
- · Multiple illness more than half of people over 60 are treated for three or more diseases.



























#### **HEALTH CARE FOR SENIORS**

### **Geriatric care - hospitalization**

- 58 hospital geriatric wards with 1 208 beds
- 34 182 hospitalizations

### Long-term care

- 771 care and treatment facilities as well as nursing and care facilities with 37 829 beds
- Home care 1 708 277 services
- Care in a care and treatment facility 41 953 services

### Palliative and hospice care

- 118 stationary hospices 2 430 beds
- 798 home hospices
- 12 day palliative or hospice care centers 96 places

#### **Health resort treatment**

• 381 848 people aged 65 and over took advantage of the health resort treatment - 47.2% of all patients



























#### **SOCIAL WELFARE FOR SENIORS**

• Daily care homes: 468 units, 19 019 places

• Family nursing homes: 33 units, 228 places

• Social welfare homes: 823 units, 81 004 places

• Sheltered housing: 1 106 houses, 3 812 places

• Non-public social welfare homes (business activity, foundations, associations, no decision required): 72 527 people 60+ (65% of all residents of these homes).
